I have to return herewith your First Entry report No.29716 on the new steamer "CONDESA", together with the plan of midship section for this vessel, and to request that you will be good enough to state whether G & H strakes of plating are .70" thick as shewn on the sketch of midshipsection, or H & J strakes as stated in the report, in view of the butts of G & H strakes being stated to have been quadruple riveted as required for the increased thickness.

You should also forward the approved plan of the deckhouses &c., and state on which the deck the cast iron coaling scuttles are fitted.
