

CONFIRMATION OF LETTER.

With reference to your letter of the 24th ultimo respecting the case of the S.S. "DARTMOUTH", I have to inform you that the fee of £2:2:0 to which you refer as being outstanding for your last report of progress forwarded to the owners, was paid on the 31st July last and you were duly advised of the payment on the 4th August, 1915.

In view of your having been under the impression that the fee was outstanding, I have looked into the matter and found that the fees for the four reports of progress furnished on this vessel were received at this office on the 20th April, 22nd May, 23rd June and 4th August, 1915 respectively. By an oversight however you do not appear to have been advised of the payment of the fee for the first report, and this has led to the present misapprehension but your accounts have now been adjusted in this respect.
