REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR *Damage to Rudder*

While on a voyage from Trondjem to Fecamp very heavy weather was encountered on Oct. 30th, and it is presumed that some submerged object struck the rudder breaking the rudder stock about 3 feet below the poop deck.

As the vessel was urgently required to proceed to France with a cargo, a new upper portion was welded on the iron rudder stock. The weld was made under my personal supervision and the stock was reinforced in way of same by fitting a sleeve $\frac{3}{4}$ in. thick. A new rudder ^{stock} will be forged and fitted at the first favourable opportunity.
