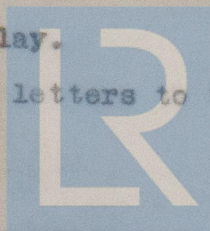
With regard to the case of the "SAN FRANCISCO", I have to confirm the following telegrams which have passed between us today:-
