

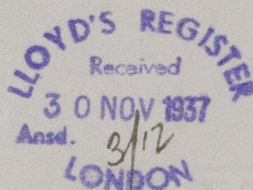

We submit for the consideration of the Committee blue prints, in triplicate, showing proposed shafting for the above sister Contracts.

The shafting was considered on 21st December, 1936 and the minimum sizes approved for intermediate shafting and tail shafts were 308 m.m. and 341 m.m. respectively.

Messrs. Doxford state the flywheels have been increased from 20 tons feet² to 58 tons feet² to suit torsional vibration conditions.
