E. I return herewith one copy of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 3rd instant, of Boilers Nos. 6254/5/6 proposed by Messrs. Stockton Chemical Engineers & Riley Bros., for Messrs. Wm. Doxford & Sons' Yard Nos. 639, 202 and 640, and have to acquaint you that this plan of cylindrical boilers will be approved for a working pressure of 120 lb. per sq. inch, provided the boilers be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the shell plates and butt straps, viz:- 29-33 tons per sq. inch.
