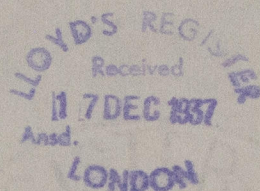

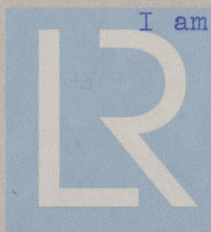
I have to state that The Optimum Davit Co. has received an order for two sets of Optimum Davits for the above ship for cargo lifeboats 28' x 8.5' x 3.5'.

As 11'-3" keel travel is required these Davits will be built to the 30 ft. standard cargo design and as the Davits are urgently required, four corresponding Davits, originally intended for Messrs. Lithgow's No. 911, are being utilised.

Two sets of Davits for 18 ft. gig and 16 ft. dinghy are also being built to the design 16x to 19x, the castings being drawn from stock.
