I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th instant enclosing plans (in duplicate) of midship section, profile and decks for the Steel Screw Motor Ship No. 640 to be built by Messrs. W. Doxford & Sons Ltd., and with regard thereto I have to inform you that provided the scantlings and arrangements as shown and amended on these plans be adhered to, the Rules in all other respects be complied with, and the materials and workmanship be to the Society's satisfaction, the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100A1, with a freeboard corresponding to a draught not exceeding that contemplated by the Rules for a complete superstructure ship having a tonnage opening.
