QUESTION.

I have to acquaint you that to complete the Boiler Survey, which became due at the end of August last year, and to entitle the vessel to a record of B.S.10,39, the starboard boiler collision chock requires to be repaired, and the safety valves of the port boiler adjusted under steam.

The Screwshaft Survey became due in this case at the end of April last, and as it is understood that the vessel is now managed by Messrs. Dent & Co. of your port, I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made for the above matters to receive attention.
