I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 13th instant and enclosed communications from Mr. Lyle and the City of Cork Steam Packet Co., Ltd., relating to the motorship "INNISFALLEN", and with regard thereto, I have to inform you that in view of the position and arrangement of the air pipes, the storm valves may be dispensed with as desired, provided a hole be drilled in the top of the air pipes in order to prevent syphon action. These remarks also apply in the case of the "ULSTER MONARCH".

I may add that reports have not yet come to hand relating to the "ULSTER QUEEN" and "ULSTER PRINCE".
