m.v. "Innisfallen"

With reference to your Freeboard Assignment letter of the 3rd inst., giving new Free Board markings of the above vessel, subject to certain alterations, we shall be glad if you will further consider item No. 1 referring to air pipes from double bottom tanks. We would point out that this ship is of very recent construction, and complies in its entirety with the latest rules applying to passenger vessels of her type.

We are of the opinion that as these air pipes are fitted above the Freeboard deck to a height of 4' 6" before returning down through this deck, there appears no possibility of water entering the tanks, although the outlet is through the shell at a distance of one foot below the main deck.

Owing to the newness of this ship we feel that this requirement should be waived in vessels of this type, which have been so recently constructed, and would respectfully submit that this item regarding air pipes should be given further favourable consideration.
