With reference to your Report No. 10353 in respect of the T.S.M.S. "INNISFALLEN", Messrs. Harland & Wolff's Yard No. 870, I have to request that you will state how the Registered Depth is arrived at, as it would appear that this should be 14.92 instead of 15.25.

You should also state the character and extent of all sheathing on the freeboard deck and forward a sketch of the portable covers over the forward and after wells showing how these are secured and how the tarpaulins are fitted over the centre portions,

In addition, I shall be glad to learn if any freeing ports are fitted above the upper deck.
