

We have to inform you that a Timber Assignment is required for the above vessel.

The particulars of fittings are as follows :-

Rule 86: Poop and forecastle fitted.

Rule 88: Nos. 3, 4, & 5 D.B. tanks have watertight centre girder. Wood plugs have been fitted in No. 2 tank. ✓

Rule 89: The bulwarks are 5'-0" in height with 7" x 3" B.A. stays spaced 5'-9" apart. The rail is 7" x 3" B.A. ✓

Rule 90: The steam and hand steering gear is in the poop space. ✓

Rule 91: Eyeplates for lashings are riveted to the sheerstrake spaced 9'-9" apart. The end eyeplates are spaced not more than 6'-6" from superstructure ends. Angle sockets spaced 9'-9" are fitted to the stringer plate.
