With reference to your letter of the 11th instant and freeboard report in respect of the s.s. "LANGLEECRAG", Messrs. Palmers' S.B. & I. Co's Yard No. 991, I now send herewith the usual assignment letters giving the freeboards assigned to this vessel.

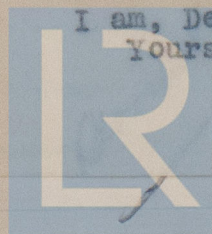
With regard to the scuppers from the tonnage exempted tween deck space, I have to inform you that these are required by the Rules to have storm valves or some other approved appliances.

The alternative appliances should consist of non-detachable screw plugs, fitted in positions which are always accessible, or capable of being operated from the deck above, but it would appear that such an arrangement will involve the inclusion of the space in the tonnage measurement of the ship.

The cases referred to by you are not comparable, as they have only short detached superstructures.
