The poop deck of this vessel was originally sheathed. This sheathing was subsequently omitted, and the Surveyors raised the question as to whether two plates, .25 in thickness, could be accepted in No. 1119 and the sister ships Nos. 1120/5/6. This was agreed to. In subsequent vessels the Builders arranged to order the plates .30 in thickness.

The Freeboard Department were informed that the scantlings were suitable for a moulded draught of 20.68'. There is nothing further in the correspondence affecting the First Entry.
