The North Eastern Marine Engineering Co. Ltd., attend at their Works on March 5th 1930 and subsequent dates, for the purpose of inspecting and testing the Boiler built for Contract No. 2482, and intended to be fitted in Messrs. Abdala & Mitchell's Yard No. 464.

The Boiler was examined internally and externally and no deterioration whatever was found to have taken place.

The Boiler was surveyed during construction by the Surveyors to Lloyd's Register. The scantlings are in accordance with the Society's Rules for a working pressure of 180 lbs. per square inch, and the workmanship good. The Boiler having been retested in my presence on 5th March 1930, by hydraulic pressure to 320 lbs. per square inch, showed no signs of weakness and was found tight and sound in every respect at that pressure. Working pressure not to exceed one hundred and eighty lbs. per square inch.
